Charalambos Vrasidas is founder and Executive Director of CARDET (www.cardet.org), an international non-profit based in Cyprus with more than two decades of global engagement. He is Professor of Learning Innovations & Policy at the University of Nicosia. A lifelong learner, a teacher, researcher, innovator, and social entrepreneur, he led the design and implementation of hundreds of initiatives and projects in more than 40 countries. With a passion for education, digital learning, and social justice he represents Cyprus in European and international networks (e.g. CONCORD, EAEA, ICEM). He has published several books and more than 100 articles in journals, edited volumes and conference proceedings. For over a decade he served on the Executive Committee of the International Council for Educational Media (an UNESCO affiliated) and as Editor-in-Chief for the scholarly journal Educational Media International. His team coordinated the development of the Cyprus Lifelong Learning Strategy 2021-2027, in partnership with EAEA and the Ministry of Education, and the National Strategy for Civic Engagement and Participatory Democracy. He has consulted globally, and his work has been supported by the European Commission, the United Nations Development Program, OECD, YALE, EuropeAid, USAID, governments, and agencies from around the world. He is Director of the Cyprus Education Summit, and the global event Learning Innovations Summit (www.learningsummit.eu).
