Dr Patouris is the Co-Founder and Director of RESET- Research and Education in Social Empowerment and Transformation, an international centre with the purpose to build a prosperous society through research and education, transformative dialogue, and participatory action. Eliza leads the fundraising activities of the organisation, while she is actively leading on several initiatives of RESET concerning youth engagement, civic participation, prevention of radicalisation and social inclusion. Eliza has managed 150+ National and EU programmes on entrepreneurship education, sustainable development, youth engagement and social empowerment.
