Dr Papadopoulos holds a PhD in Information and Communication Technologies in Education from the School of Informatics, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece. Before joining UT, he held positions at Aarhus University (Denmark), the International Institute for Software Technology at United Nations University (Macau SAR, China), and Carnegie Mellon University in Qatar (Qatar).

He has worked on several funded research projects in Europe, Qatar, and Macau SAR, including openSE, Kaleidoscope NoE, and Arabiyyatti, for which he developed educational applications on multitouch surface computers for kids. Dr Papadopoulos has been the project or team coordinator of several EU-funded projects, such as the Erasmus+ project *InnoEntre* (Innovation and Entrepreneurship in Open Higher Education), *colMOOC* (Integrating Conversational Agents and Learning Analytics in MOOC), and the currently running *L2BGreen* (Learning to be Green: An AI-enhanced multilingual online course for developing a green entrepreneurial mindset).

His work lies in the intersection of innovative technologies and learning sciences. His work is published in more than 80 top-ranking international peer-reviewed journals and conferences. He is a member of the scientific committee in several top-ranking international conferences and a reviewer of major journals in his domain. He is a member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE), the International Society of the Learning Sciences (ISLS), and the Association for the Advancement of Computing in Education (AACE). Finally, he is a member of the editorial board of the *Journal of Computer Assisted Learning*, and an elected member of the Computer-Supported Collaborative Learning committee of the ISLS.
