**Wioletta Kilar** is a PhD in geography, specialising in economic geography. She works at the University of the National Education Commission, Krakow (Poland), where she is the Head of the Entrepreneurship Education Research Group. From 2023, she is a Fellow of the Cañada Blanch Centre LSE-Miguel Dols Fellows Scheme at the London School of Economics and Political Science (UK).

Her research interests focus on issues of entrepreneurship education (including soft skills) and geography education at all levels of education (from pre-school to higher education); formation and functioning of enterprises (especially transnational corporations); formation of global value chains (GVCs); factors of location and development of transnational corporations and their branches; innovativeness of enterprises, national economies and local governments; the formation of entrepreneurial ecosystems; changes in socio-economic development in Poland and other European Union countries, with particular emphasis on the importance of industry and human resources in this process.

She is the author and co-author many scientific publications in this field in national and international journals, co-authored textbooks for secondary schools in the basics of entrepreneurship and geography, as well as expert opinions, educational and didactic materials. She was the manager and team member of many research and educational projects in the field of entrepreneurship and geography, including international projects.

As an expert in entrepreneurship education, she cooperates with a number of institutions, including the Polish Ministry of National Education (as co-author of the core curriculum for the basics of entrepreneurship for secondary schools), the Polish Ministry of Finance for financial education.
